Blitz Survival Sheet | May 12–14

WHAT INSPECTORS ARE TARGETING

- ELD Tampering & Falsification (ghost driving, unassigned drive time, signal blockers)
- ELD Data Transfer Failures (email & web services must work)
- Cargo Securement (worn straps, damaged chains, loose dunnage)
- Brake Systems, Lights, Tires, Air Leaks
- Log Accuracy Cross-Checked with Fuel, Tolls, GPS & BOLs

DRIVER CHECKLIST (Complete Before May 12)

- Clear ALL unassigned driving time
- Test ELD data transfer (email & web services)
- Organize CDL, Medical Card, Registration, Insurance
- Inspect brakes, lights, tires, ABS light cycle
- Replace questionable straps or chains
- Secure all loose dunnage and tools
- Re-check load securement after first 50 miles

WHAT HAPPENS DURING BLITZ WEEK

- PASS: You receive a CVSA decal (may reduce inspection chances for ~3 months).
- FAIL: Critical violations result in Out-of-Service (OOS) until fixed — no exceptions.
